Seasonal Firefighter Position Opening

THE POSITION:

The Seasonal Firefighter position will supplement our current staffing during our seasonal uptake in call volume by providing a second Firefighter on shift daily. The Seasonal Firefighter work responsibilities include: responding to and dealing with emergencies, natural conditions that pose a threat to life and property, and incidents of service to the citizens. Employees in this position are responsible for the protection of life and property through firefighting activities, emergency medical services, community risk reduction programs, and other duties as assigned. This position will likely require deployment to wildland fires and may require mobilization of up to 2 weeks at a time.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must possess a valid Driver's License and EVIP card.
- Red Card Certified, Wildland Firefighter Type 2 (Firefighter Type 1 preferred.) Must be able to complete a 3 mile walk with a 45 lb. pack in 45 minutes.
- Current WA State EMT credential preferred but not required.
- IFSAC Firefighter I/II, Hazmat Operations preferred but not required.

WAGES:

\$22.00 to \$25.00 per hour depending upon shift worked and qualifications. No other paid benefits.
